### National Consistent Collection of Data (NCCD) for School Students with Disabilities

All schools in Australia, including Independent and Catholic schools, will participate in the National Consistent Collection of Data (NCCD) for School Students with Disabilities every year.

The Data Collection is an annual count of the number of students with disability receiving educational adjustments to support their participation in education on the same basis as students without disability.

All education agencies are now required to provide information on a student's level of education, disability and level of adjustment to the Australian Government Department of Education. No student's identity will be provided to the Australian Government Department of Education.
